

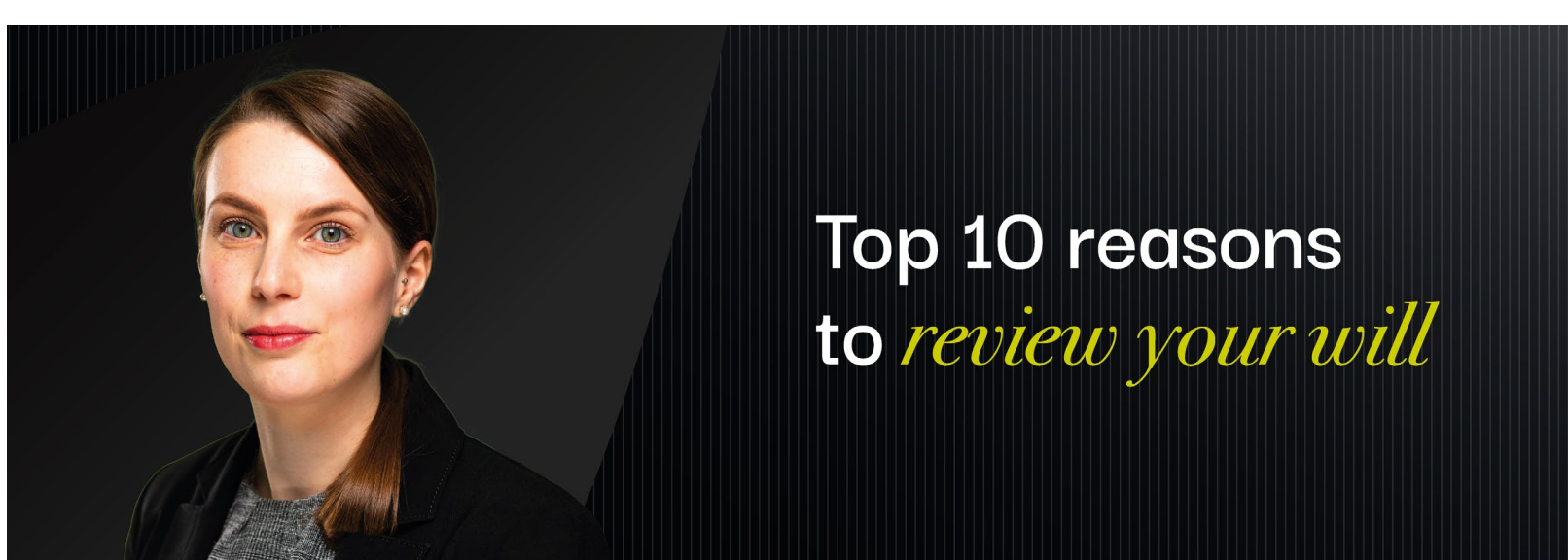


Spring incoming

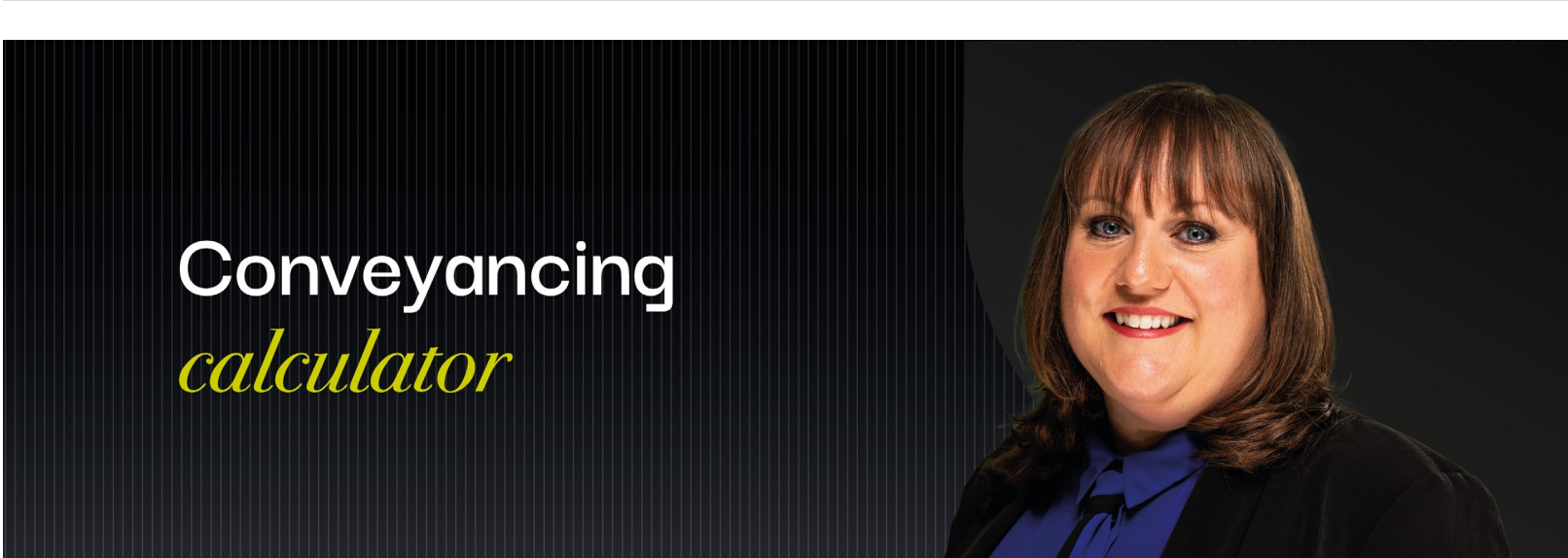

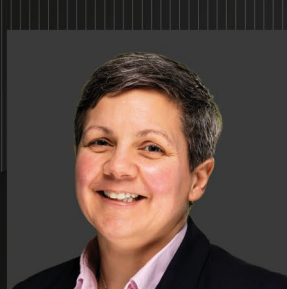
